Context and Background

In light of Germany's Feminist Development Policy and GIZ's commitment towards ensuring Gender Equality is a quality aspect of our work, the **FMB** Department Gender Team has developed a [GTA Self-Assessment Tool](#) that can be applied by interested project/program teams.

It is intended to answer the question of whether a project, measure or activity applies **Gender-Transformative Approaches (GTA)** and, if so, how great the gender-transformative potential is. The tool can be used as a participatory team exercise also together with external stakeholders. The GTA Participatory Self-Assessment Tool provides the key elements regarding the content and process to assess the GTA potential in a project/module. The tool can be used as a self-assessment by staff involved in project planning and implementation, including e.g. AV, Advisors, Gender Focal Persons, Project team members, or Planning officers.
