

Strengthening Criminal Prosecution of Gender-Based Violence in Latin America and The Caribbean

The online training programme comprises:

- Protocols for recording reports of gender-based violence by victims and assessing the need for protective measures during the investigation
 - Pre-trial risk assessment to determine the need for injunctions or orders to protect victims
- Use of alternatives to trial and summary criminal proceedings
- Application of case theory in the investigation of genderbased violence
- Gender-sensitive approach in the prosecution of gender-based violence

The face-to-face course localises the content (laws, jurisprudence, context), featuring an online animated case.
