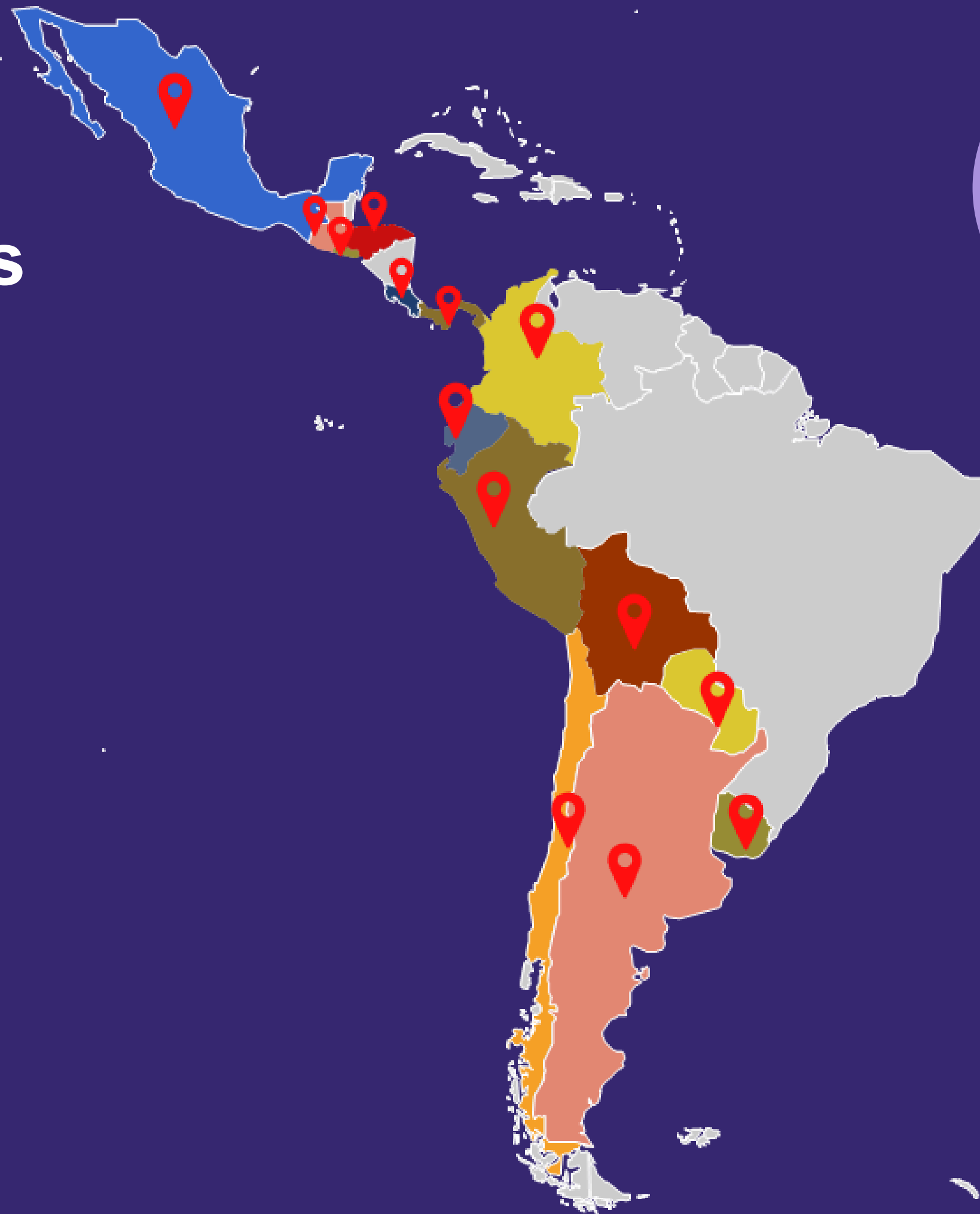

# Strengthening Criminal Prosecution of Gender-Based Violence in Latin America and The Caribbean

The online training programme comprises:

- 1 Protocols for recording reports of gender-based violence by victims and assessing the need for protective measures during the investigation
- 2 Pre-trial risk assessment to determine the need for injunctions or orders to protect victims
- 3 Use of alternatives to trial and summary criminal proceedings
- 4 Application of case theory in the investigation of gender-based violence
- 5 Gender-sensitive approach in the prosecution of gender-based violence

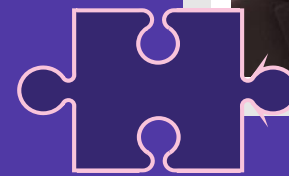
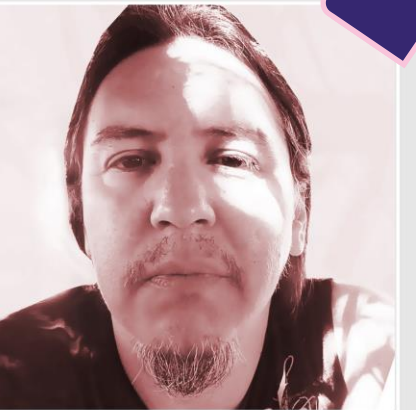


The face-to-face course localises the content (laws, jurisprudence, context), featuring an online animated case.
